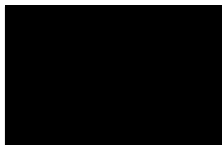

COMPLIANCE WITH IMPROVEMENT NOTICE

On 13 February 2015 you were served with an Improvement Notice in relation to your registered child minding service Louise Nimmo, [REDACTED] in terms of section 62 of the Public Services Reform (Scotland) Act 2010 ("the Act"). The Improvement Notice stated that unless there was a significant improvement in provision of the service, Social Care and Social Work Improvement Scotland (hereinafter referred to as "the Care Inspectorate") intended to make a proposal to cancel your registration. The Improvement Notice specified the nature of the improvements to be made, and the period within which they were to be made.

As there has been a significant improvement in the service, the Care Inspectorate has decided not to proceed to make a proposal to cancel registration of the service. Our conclusions about the improvements made are noted below.

On 23 February 2105 you submitted a fully completed application with relevant payment for membership of the Protection of Vulnerable Groups (PVG) Scheme for regulated work with children to the Care Inspectorate (including verification of identity) as required by the Improvement Notice.

A copy of this notice has been sent to the local authority of the area in which the service is provided.

The Improvement Notice dated 13 February 2015 is no longer in force.
